

Student Transportation (B-8)

The district does not provide daily transportation of regular education students to and from school. The district does provide a daily shuttle bus between elementary schools, and it does provide transportation for extra-curricular contests and practices. Daily busing of students transferring from Milwaukee is provided by Milwaukee Public Schools.

Transportation requirements of EEN students shall be consistent with the transportation requirements of the student's IEP.

Transportation for students who are physically and/or mentally disabled shall be provided as determined by the director of special education. Transportation provisions may include the employment of aides, specially equipped vehicles, changes in routing and pick-up points, and private contracts with parents. Drivers and operators of vehicles transporting students with exceptional educational needs shall be informed of any conditions which may require special care.

Students shall observe all established rules and regulations related to riding buses and may be suspended from the use of bus transportation for misbehavior in violation of established rules. Principals shall establish appropriate rules and regulations for students riding buses.
