

## **Food Service (B-9)**

The district shall participate in the national and state school noon lunch and special milk programs and shall accept responsibility for providing free and reduced price meals to students. In fulfilling this responsibility, the district shall:

1. Permit no physical segregation of or any other discrimination against any student because of inability to pay the designated price of the meals.
2. Serve meals free or at a reduced price to any student who is a member of a family having an annual income not above the applicable family size income level set forth in Income Poverty Guidelines prescribed by the Secretary of Agriculture.
3. Follow a hearing procedure as required by the national school lunch program.
4. Abide by policies established for school districts participating in the national school lunch and special milk programs by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction.

Food services for the district are provided by a food services contractor under an annually renewable contract.

The contractor may provide food and/or meals to district and quasi-public organizations provided district facilities are adequate and available.
