

Full-Time Students (D-5a)

A full-time student is a student scheduled to attend school for the hours delineated according to Policy D-5. Students must be in attendance for the full day course of study. Students with special needs may have programs modified to meet the requirements of their individual educational plans. High School students involved in school-sponsored, off-campus study, youth options, supervised work experience, or advance placement programming (such as enrollment in courses at a college, university or enrolled part-time in another district) may include that portion of their program in the minimum time required to be full-time.
