

Emergency Drills, School Closings, Building Security, Student Lockers and Use of Tobacco (D-7)

Fire and tornado drills shall be conducted in each school building on a regular basis. Directions for students and staff shall be posted in each classroom.

The superintendent of schools or designee shall close schools when the safety or welfare of students is endangered. Closings will be announced on the following radio/TV stations:

All visitors shall report to the school office to obtain authorization for visiting. Loitering in school buildings or on school grounds without authorization is prohibited. District employees are authorized to enforce this prohibition against loitering and to request assistance from law enforcement officials if necessary.

The use of motor vehicles on school grounds shall be limited to school business.

The ownership of student lockers is maintained by the school district, and students are granted a limited use of lockers on the basis of school procedures and rules. School authorities may access lockers at any time and may make periodic inspections.

Use of tobacco is prohibited in school buildings and on district property.
