

Conflicts of Interest (C-9)

Conduct of Business

Employees of the district shall not: (1) act as agent for sale of supplies or equipment to the district, (2) receive any fee or reward for any such sales, (3) accept anything of value (solicited or unsolicited) for personal use from any person or company which has done, does or may do business with the district.

Tutoring

A teacher shall not tutor for compensation students who are currently enrolled in the teacher's class or classes unless the teacher has volunteered to tutor the student under approved homebound instruction. Tutoring students for a fee shall not be conducted within any school building in the district.

Solicitations by Staff Members

Staff members shall not read or permit to be read to students and staff members or circulate among them any document or article of non-educational value. Staff members shall not sell tickets or other items of merchandise in the school building without the consent of the principal. Announcements of outside entertainment or activities of a civic nature or interest and benefit which principals deem entirely worthy may be called to the attention of the students with consent of the principal.

Solicitations of Staff Members

Staff members shall not permit interviews on school time or at the school buildings with persons whose object is to have them make personal purchases or investments. No other form of solicitation of staff members shall be permitted unless permission is given by the superintendent. Students shall not sell tickets of any kind or other items of merchandise in the school building without the consent of the principal.
