



## **Construction Safety**

As you are probably aware, the St. Francis School District is currently under construction at all three school locations. Through the support of the St. Francis community, the district passed a referendum that has called for a number of upgrades, renovations and additions that will greatly improve our school environments.

In order to provide all school and community members with a safe experience during this process, we ask that you review the below mentioned information and follow the guidelines provided. Thank you for your cooperation and support.

### Site Activity

It is imperative to your safety and the safety of the construction personnel that you avoid contact with active sites. Please follow the directions of all posted signage and avoid entering into any areas that are fenced off, taped or otherwise marked for construction. If there is any doubt, do not enter the area and ask official personnel for clarification.

### Site Traffic

During the course of the construction process, the required traffic flow and patterning may vary dependent of the need to accommodate construction traffic and safety. Please drive slow, follow the directions of all posted signage, use caution when navigating the school parking lots and be aware of surroundings. Your patience is critical to the safety of our students, staff, the construction personnel and yourself.

### Reporting

If you witness any unauthorized personnel entering into an active construction site or you witness anyone driving in a manner that is unsafe, please contact the appropriate school office (during school hours) and/or contact the St. Francis Police Department. When doing so, please report any identifiable information that will assist with following-up. (i.e. the description of the person, description of the vehicle, time, location, etc.)
