NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the qualified electors of the St. Francis School District that the three-year terms of Russell J. Iwanski and Diane F. Mayer will expire on April 26, 2010. Therefore, in the General Election on April 6, 2010, two (2) persons will be elected to fill the two (2) 3-year terms on the St. Francis School Board.

Any qualified elector interested in becoming a candidate must file a written declaration with the School District Clerk. Circulation of nomination papers is not necessary. The geographic area served by the St. Francis School District is identical to that served by the City of St. Francis. Candidacy papers and forms are available at the St. Francis School District Office beginning December 1, 2009.

The notarized written declaration should read as follows:

“I, _____, being duly sworn, state that I am a candidate for the office of St. Francis School District board member and I meet or will meet at the time I assume office the applicable age, citizenship, residency and voting qualification requirements, if any, prescribed by the constitutions and laws of the United States and the State of Wisconsin, and that I will otherwise qualify for office, if nominated and elected. I have not been convicted of a felony in any court within the United States for which I have not been pardoned. I have not been convicted of a misdemeanor involving a violation of public trust for which I have not been pardoned. My present municipality of residence for voting purposes is:_____. My name as I wish it to appear on the official ballot is as follows:_____.” Signature of candidate.

Written declarations must be filed with, School District Clerk, Attention – Mrs. Carol Topinka, St. Francis School District, 4225 South Lake Drive – Room 201, St. Francis, WI 53235.

Deadline for filing declarations of candidacy is five o'clock p.m. (5:00 p.m.), Tuesday, January 5, 2010.

If there are more than four (4) candidates, a primary election will be held February 16, 2010.
