WISCONSIN'S COMPULSORY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

(Section 118.15, WI Statutes)

1. Children between the ages of 6 and 18 years must attend school regularly while they are in Wisconsin.
2. Local school districts are required to enforce this law in coordination with other school and social service agencies within their counties during the school year (Section 118.16, WI Statutes).
3. If your children are between 6 and 18 years of age when school opened this fall, they must enroll in and regularly attend school while you reside in the school district. Modified programs for students between 16 and 18 years of age are possible only through written agreements between school personnel and parents.
4. Any person who contributes to the habitual truancy of a pupil is subject to a fine, not to exceed \$500.00, or to imprisonment, not to exceed 30 days, or both (Section 939.51 (3)(c) WI Statutes).
