I. Finances

Marilyn discussed how much was in the Music Boosters Account. The Citrus Fruit “people” were paid and now the balance is roughly \$6,000.

II. St. Francis Days – Mrs. Doty noted that the teen tent last year was not affiliated with the schools. Electricity is an issue for this year's tent. Where we will be placed is in an area where there is not much electricity left for us to use. We will discuss more at a future meeting.

III. Logo Contest. Flyer was finished the night of January 27<sup>th</sup> and emailed to the teachers. Published in Wednesday take home packets on February 4<sup>th</sup> with a deadline of February 25<sup>th</sup>.

IV. The teachers reported that their principals approved payment for most of the items on their wish lists. Shells are a big request and may be a larger priced item to save for during fundraisers. Mrs. Doty said that she thinks more microphones would be convenient to have. Asking the administration first before having the music boosters pay for them. Mrs. Lewis also made mention that the storage room at Deer Creek will NOT be her classroom starting next school year. There has been discussion about moving downstairs in the “tunnel,” but we have been informed that those spaces flood, which would be devastating to our equipment. If they decide to hold band/choir in the music room then Beth will be retracting most (if not all) of her wish list item requests because there will be no point to having them if they are forced into a space that small.

V. Scholarships from 2007-2008 school year still need to be paid out. A total of \$1,150 is set to be paid out to the recipients. Discussed the idea of coming up with more defined protocol of a deadline to hand in 1<sup>st</sup> semester transcripts in order to receive the scholarship. Scholarships that are not picked up by deadline would be returned back into account. Discuss further at a future meeting. A committee was put together to work on ideas on scholarship procedures. Marilyn Glavin, Laura Boknevit and Mr. Oestreich volunteered. Marilyn is also creating letters to go out to the kids from last year who still have scholarships coming to them.

VI. New business was discussed with the concept of asking for money in a letter going out from music students to fundraise simply by getting a donation. Also discussed creating an introduction/brochure about the Music Boosters Association. Mrs. Doty brought up Miller Park and doing concessions for an event to bring in proceeds.
