

**Meeting Minutes for St Francis Public Schools Music Boosters Ass'n

**Old Business**

November 6<sup>th</sup> Craft Fair: We are still looking for crafters. If anyone knows of any, give members of the craft fair committee the info so they can make contact with them. Craft Fair will be at Willow Glen this year.

Other items mentioned at the last Craft Fair Committee meeting: Having a large item (that we purchase) to auction off. There is a SF school parent that works at Best Buy who could be contacted for a good deal or possibly a merchandise donation.

We are considering having entertainment at the craft fair.

Camcorder for concert recording: Mrs Doty priced some camcorders at Best Buy and presented an approximate amount for a purchase. A motion was made and approved for \$550 to buy a camcorder and accessories (including a microphone). This would be used by all three SF schools.

Terry Junker thanked everyone for their help on Open Mic Night. He would like suggestions for next year. Should the venue be changed? Would the music teachers prepare a performance?

**New Business**

Clarinet purchase request: Mrs Lewis requested 2 clarinets- at \$409 each – to be rented and used by Deer Creek band students. A motion was made and approved to purchase the 2 clarinets.

Dennis works in a Bay View school and will look into what instruments/music equipment the schools may be getting rid of.

Susan suggested seeing a “wish list” – in September 2010- from the teachers, for requests they think they will be making in the 2010-2011 school year. This will help us plan the budget.

The SFHS play will be in April 2011.

Mr O submitted a request for the SFMB's to run the "shack" during one football game in the fall. He is waiting to hear if our organization was picked.

There is an opening at the SF Community Center to run the Bingo kitchen once a month on a Friday night. Mrs Doty suggested trading off between the 3 SF schools for the help needed in running the kitchen. Lisa will make contact with the Community Center.

Mr O will not need the \$80 we approved for his choir group to attend the opera (he was able to get a good deal on the tickets). He would like to use the money, instead, to put towards a bus needed for the SFHS music students to attend "Wicked" in July. This was approved

Susan suggested opening up the "Wicked" trip to SFMB's, students and their families. It was agreed that this would be hard to set up in the one week left of school. We can look into a similar trip for next year.

Mr O is letting us know of a future request for a tuba. He already made a \$600 profit from a candle fundraiser that will be used towards this purchase.

Mr O is still selling candy at the SFHS. Sales are good. A parent donated the last batch of candy, so the \$100 we approved for candy supply purchase was not needed.
