CONTACT THE DISTRICT NURSE

State your student's name, grade and teacher. List the symptoms your student is having and when they started. Then list a phone number that you can be reached for follow up questions or guidance.

ANSWER THE CALL

The Nurse will be in contact

If your student's symptoms meet criteria for isolation, the District Nurse will call you to discuss the dates of isolation.

GET TESTED

If your student's symptoms meet the criteria for isolation, a negative COVID-19 test can get them back to school sooner. There are many options for testing in the Milwaukee area. The state also offers a free saliva test that they will send you in the mail. Notify the Nurse of your student's test results.

CHECK IN

Coming back after isolation

When your student's isolation period is coming to an end, check in with the district nurse to make sure it is safe for your student to return. If it is safe, your student will need to check in at the office on their first day back for a temp check and a symptom screen.
